

# Leaf Pick-Up

**January 16-17, 2023**

The Laurel Thicket Leaf Pick-up will take place on January 16 and 17. Dates may be extended or rescheduled based on weather conditions. The following guidelines have been developed by the LTPOA Board of Directors to insure the best possible service.

- ✓ The accumulation of leaves along roads may begin the week of December 26, 2022.
- ✓ Piles should consist of leaves only. Do not include sticks, branches, pine cones or needles.
- ✓ Leaf piles should be placed in front of houses and cul-de-sacs as close as possible to the road's edge and on the road side edge of any ditch in order to allow access by the removal equipment.
- ✓ Leaf piles should not be located in ditches and culverts in a way that impedes water drainage.
- ✓ Do not block USPS access to mailboxes or the passage of cars.
